

We are excited to introduce a new way to give at Ss. Cyril & Methodius Parish. We have partnered with Pushpay to accept donations online and through your mobile device. We chose Pushpay because of how simple it is to use. Once your account is set up, you can give in just seconds.

How:

- To give using your mobile device simply text SSCYRIL to 77977 and a link to the giving page will be sent to you.
- To give online you can simply go to our website: www.saintcyrils.org and select "GIVE" on the homepage.

Why:

For You:

- Having the option for online and mobile giving through Pushpay gives you the ability to set up a recurring gift and saves you the time and energy of writing checks and filling out envelopes every week.
- If you don't carry cash and you don't write checks, this allows you the opportunity to practice sacrificial giving using ACH payments or a credit card.
- It allows you to change the amount of your gift or cancel in just seconds if your circumstance changes.
- Most special collections will be set up as a fund option in online and mobile giving.
- You will be able to review all your online/mobile gifts at any time in your online account.

For the Church:

- Saves the Church time and increases giving record accuracy by automatically recording your gifts in your donor records.
- Decreases the work load of our volunteer counting team who work so hard to count each week's collections.



Bugan, Jakub Olekšak, Ján Svitnic, Andrej Kralik, Ján Opal, Juraj Bajus, Ján Malik starši, stari vibor pozostava z nasledovnich Dominik Oleksak, Štefan Cenkner, Štefan Durina, Bela Tarabek a T. Vojtašek, teda celi uradni vibor pozostava z 13 členov.

Ďalej návrh bol od Brata T. Griglaka, založiť totiš zorganizovať slovenski spevokol, načo sa nehlasel nigdo, zostalo tak. Konečne sa zrobela dobrovoľna zbierka pri pričitani za zistelo, žeje skolektovane \$24.63 túto verejnú osadnú schôdzu zme skončeli ze slovenskú himnu, Hej Slováci společne.
