Why the Honor of Crowning Mary Means So Much to Me



What If I Already Give Using The Old System

If you have been using the ACH giving system and we have your email address on-file, we sent an email to you outlining the new Pushpay on-line giving program. The email included a link to set up your gift using Pushpay. Once you sign up for Pushpay, we will then cancel your old ACH gift. If we did not have your email on file or you did not receive the email, you can simply set up your gift using the new online or mobile platform and contact the Parish Office or send an email to business@saintcyrils.org requesting the old gift be canceled. We will discontinue the current ACH giving system on May 31, 2019.


