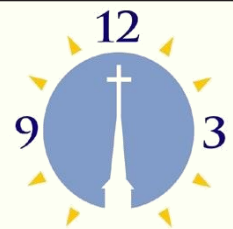

As you know, the Knights of Columbus have been Pro-Life from their inception.

In addition to the previously-completed Prolife Poster contest, our Council is pleased to provide an update of its Baby Bottle Project for 2020. This Project was selected by Ss. Cyril and Methodius Parish as one of its 2020 Lenten Projects. This Project was involved in raising funds to provide operating and other expenses for Gianna House, a resource center for pregnant mothers, located in Eastpointe.

We were initially scheduled to collect these baby bottles the weekend of Palm Sunday but were delayed due to the closing of the Church because of the pandemic. Thankfully, we were able to collect these bottles the weekend of July 11 and 12.

Despite the fact that we received only approximately 130 of the almost 600 bottles distributed, we have had a successful fund raiser, receiving more than \$5,000 thus far. If you still have a filled bottles at home, please drop it off at the Parish Office or return it to a Knight. I am sure that Gianna House can use whatever additional funds we raise.

We are appealing for parishioners to **please return any empty bottles as well** since **each bottle costs us \$1**. We will need to replace any missing bottles for next year's fundraiser and it can become costly. Please return your **empty bottle** to the parish on weekdays (11:00AM - 2:00PM) in the box located in the vestibule or return it to a Knight. We would appreciate the return of these bottles as soon as possible and we appreciate your cooperation.

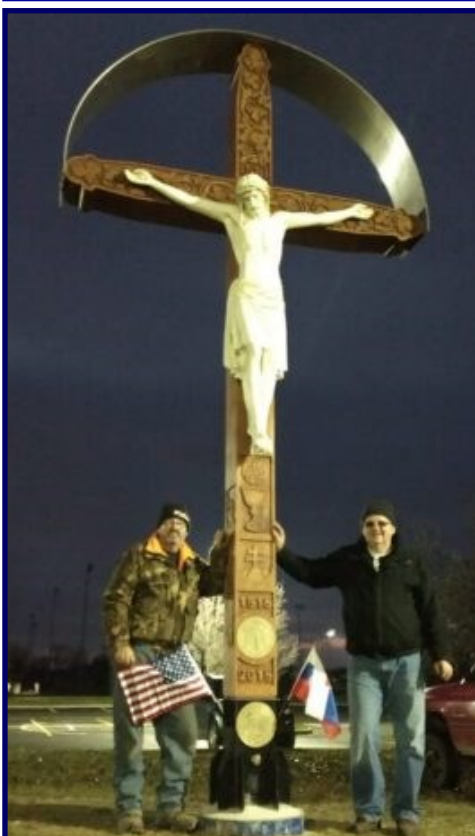
Benediction of the Anniversary Cross September 13 † 10:00AM Combined Holy Mass & Benediction

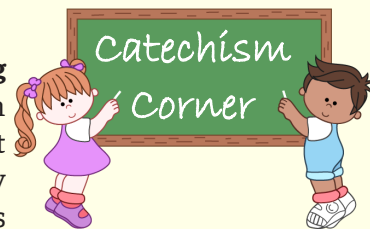
