

Did you register for Catechism? **Class sizes are filling up fast due to social distancing restrictions.** We know there is still a lot of uncertainty surrounding the next Catechism School Year but until we know how many families we will have in the program, we cannot make plans for class sizes, volunteers needed, books and the dynamics of the facility allowing for social distancing. We are planning in-person classes on Wednesday evenings beginning September 16 (starting date subject to change), unless the Governor moves us back a Phase. Details will be given to all families enrolled once they become available. We assure you that we intend to follow all State Guidelines for the safety and well-being of all the students and the volunteers, including the possibility of offering a two-night program, if necessary, in order to abide by the established guidelines. 
