Words from Pope Francis on the First World Day
for Grandparents and the Elderly † July 25, 2021

To the Grandparents and Elderly:

In a special way, old age is a time of grace, in which the Lord renews His call to us: He calls us to safeguard and transmit the faith, He calls us to pray, especially to intercede; He calls us to be close to those in need.... The elderly, grandparents have the ability to understand the most difficult of situations: a great ability! And when they pray for these situations, their prayer is strong; it is powerful! (Pope Francis, Meeting with the Elderly, Vatican, 28 September 2014)

The prayer of grandparents and of the elderly is a great gift for the Church, it is a treasure! A great injection of wisdom for the whole of human society: above all for one which is too busy, too taken, too distracted. (Pope Francis, General Audience, Vatican, 11 March 2015)

To Young People:

Do you want to be the hope for the future or not? Two conditions that cost nothing. The first condition is to remember. Trying to understand where I come from: the memory of my people, my family, my whole history. ... Memory of the path I have taken, memory of everything I have received from those who have gone before me. A young person who cannot remember is no hope for the future. Is that clear? So, ... how do I go about remembering? First, talk to your grandparents. Because if you want to be hope for the future, you have to receive the torch from your grandfather and your grandmother. Will you promise me that in preparing for Panama, you will talk more with your grandparents? If your grandparents are already in heaven, will you talk to the elderly? CATHOLIC TEACHINGS ON: THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Why do Catholics need to be Confirmed?

When we are Baptized, we are born spiritually, becoming sharers in the Divine life of the most Blessed Trinity and begin to live a "supernatural" life. But this stage of our spiritual life, like the life of a child, is largely self-centered; preoccupied with the needs of our own soul, with the effort to "be good."

Then, when we are confirmed, we receive a special grace by which our faith is deepened and strengthened. With the onset of adolescence, a child begins to assume, progressively more and more, the responsibilities of adulthood. Similarly, the confirmed Christian begins to assume his responsibility to Christ for his neighbor. A beautiful tradition is to call Confirmed Catholics "Soldiers of Christ," which beautifully indicates Confirmation's effects!

Without Confirmation it would be easy to lose our faith. That is why it is of obligation for every baptized person to be also confirmed if he has the opportunity. Jesus instituted each individual sacrament because He foresaw, in His infinite wisdom, that we would have need of certain special graces under certain particular circumstances. He foresaw, among other things, the dangers to which our Faith would be exposed, and how truly important it would be for us to be Confirmed.
