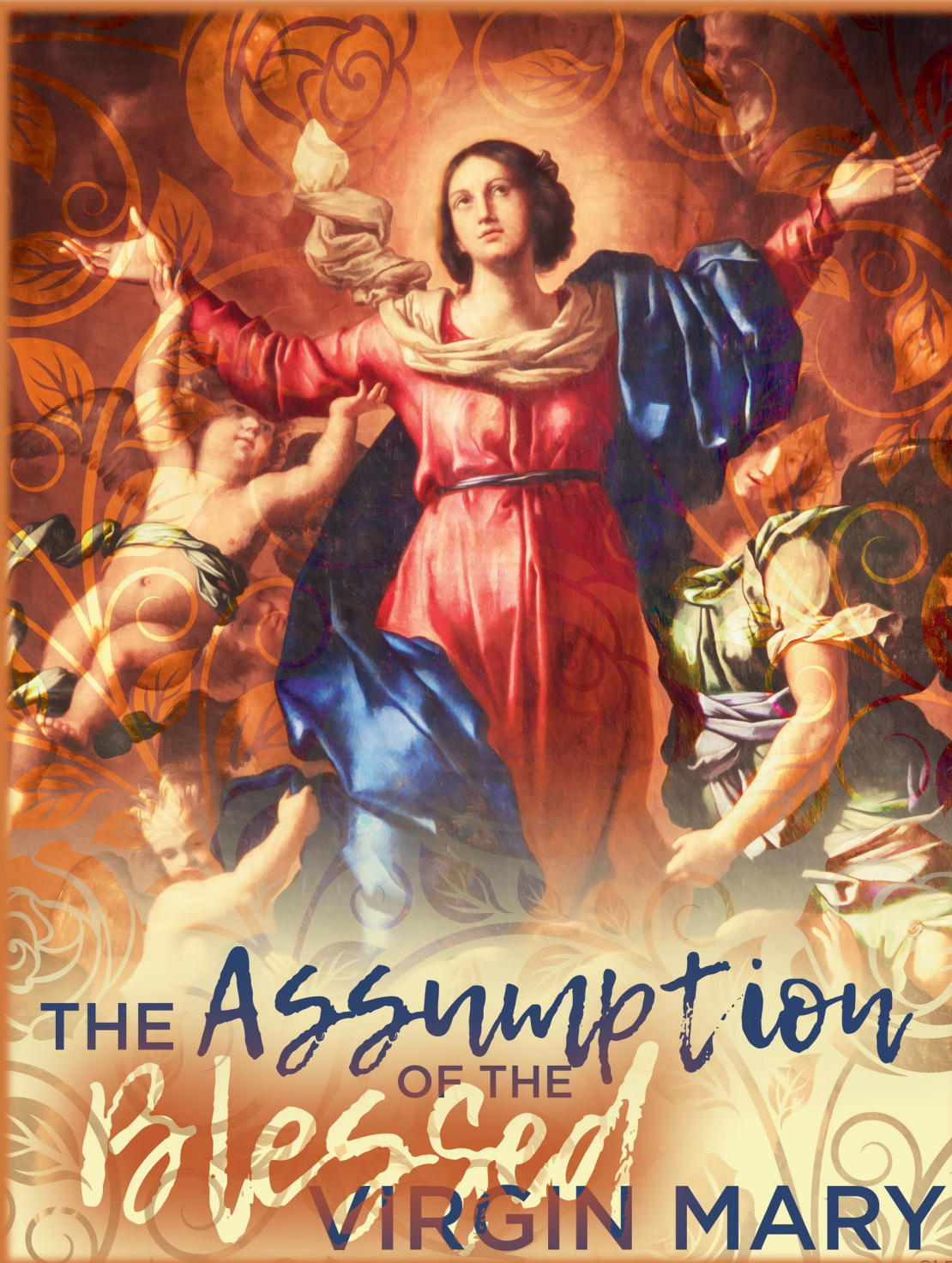

If you are new to the parish and haven't registered your child yet for catechism (grades Kindergarten through 8th Grades), please contact:

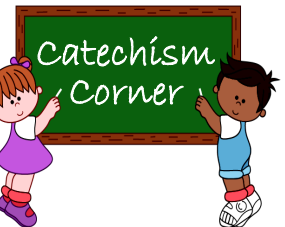

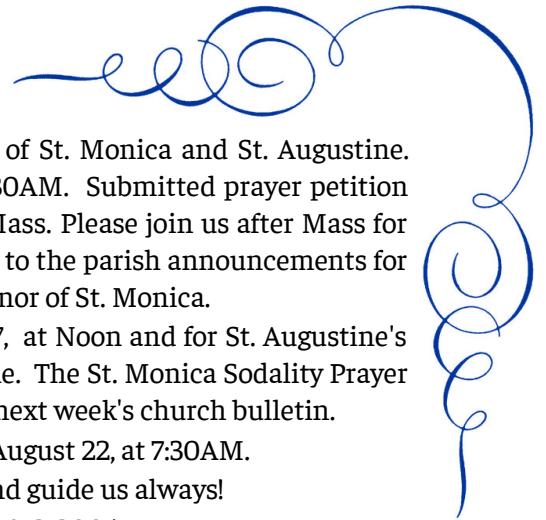
