

CSA UPDATE

Every year, our bishop and shepherd, Archbishop Vigneron, asks all parishes of the Archdiocese of Detroit to financially support projects, services, and ministries that no singular parish can run on its own. The financial burden is shared, and so are the benefits for the parishes, as well as for people in the Archdiocese and beyond. The list of projects supported this year can be found at:

The reason we do this is not just practicality, but because it is the very nature of the Church. Unlike Protestant churches and various denominations with a rather loose connection to one another, the Catholic Church in any locality exists and lives in unity with the bishop, under his leadership. We profess every Sunday in the Creed that we believe in a Church that is apostolic: built upon the foundation of the apostles and gathered around their successors. And although we worship in various parishes and have preferences when it comes to our social circles, we create just one Catholic Church. In every Holy Mass in every single parish, we pray in union "with Francis, our Pope and Allen, our Bishop".


The CSA goal set for our Parish for 2021 (\$160,134) reflects the trend of our Parish offertory over the past 3 years. So far, we have been able to reach \$100,162, which is 63% of the overall goal. This would not be possible without the generosity and sacrifice of many parishioners. We still have a long way to go, but every single donation, big or small, brings us one step closer to the goal.

The financial benefit of contributing to CSA on behalf of our Parish is immense. It serves a lot of good purposes (ministries that benefit) and even more so, it helps our Parish budget in saving 7% on diocesan assessment. If we fail to reach our CSA goal, the shortfall will have to be covered out of our Parish finances, which means that we will be losing another 7% from any donation made to the Parish. Thus, from the financial perspective, the most efficient way to support our parish is to donate to CSA on our behalf.

Fr. Marek has pursued his interest and talents for Eastern Christian iconography, studying Byzantine Iconography under the guidance of well-known iconographer Phil Zimmerman of New Florence, PA. and has painted over 700 icons for homes and churches all over the world,

He is currently serving at St. Mary's Byzantine Catholic Parish in Cleveland, Ohio. In 2018, he was also appointed the Rector of the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Parma, Ohio and the Protosyncellus (Vicar General) of the Eparchy of Parma.

Fr. Marek and his wife Miriam are happily married and have three children: Caroline (15), Elias (11), and Marco (8)

Chicago Christmas Pilgrimage of Historic Churches



2021 Parish Advent Giving Projects

Thanksgiving is in just a few days and Advent is right on its heels. As our thoughts turn to Christmas plans, shopping and decorating, we also keep in mind the importance of charity and caring for those who are suffering and in need. By opening our hearts to our brothers and sisters who can give us nothing in return, Jesus Himself enters in, filling us with the peace and joy we long for. Please consider joining with your family and your parish family to help with one or more of the following Advent Giving Projects. If you have questions about any of the projects, contact Erin Rybicki at <u>ChristianService@saintcyrils.church</u> or Sandi Brady in the Parish Office.

Giving Tree: The Giving Tree is back and will be filled with gift requests for children who are receiving services from Macomb County Community Mental Health programs, and for their foster parents. The past year has seen a large increase in families suffering from domestic crises and divorce; and many have needed the county's services, including foster care for the children. Help brighten a child or foster parent's Christmas with a special gift. **Please bring your wrapped gift, with the gift tag attached, to the Parish Office by December 12 or leave it under the Giving Tree when you come to Sunday Holy Mass.** There will also be gift tags requesting **gift cards in the amount of \$25** for parishioners-in-need and families being assisted by St. Dominic's Outreach Center. **Gift cards can be placed in the Sunday collection basket or dropped off in the Parish Office by December 12**.

Toy and Clothing Collection for St. Dominic's Outreach Center: Basements in many of the homes near St. Dominic's flooded not just once, but twice, this past summer. Besides damage to furnaces, hot water heaters and laundry, many families lost winter clothing that had been stored in their basements. To help these families get back on their feet and to celebrate Christmas, we will be collecting <u>new winter clothing</u> for children and adults (larger sizes such as XL and XXL especially are needed for teens and adults) as well as gifts such as new toys, games, basketballs and soccer balls. **Please drop off your clothing or gift donation in the gathering space or outside the Fr. Mikus Hall before Sunday Mass on December 11 or 12. Please note: <u>These are the only days to drop off donations</u>. All donations will be delivered to St. Dominic's on December 13 so they can be given to families before Christmas.**

Mary's Children Family Center Collection: After being closed for nearly a year, the day program at Mary's Children once again is caring for and bringing God's love to adults suffering from traumatic brain injury. Students begin their day together with the rosary, then participate in individualized projects and activities, coming together in the center's chapel to pray the Divine Mercy chaplet before going to their homes. With a 2:1 student to caregiver ratio, each student is helped to participate as they are able and to reach their individual, full potential. In order to help the center offset its significant expenses, we will be collecting **Lysol wipes, paper towels, toilet paper, facial tissue and individual servings of applesauce. Please bring your donation to Sunday Mass on December 11 or 12 and place it on the cart in the vestibule or outside the Fr. Mikus Hall. <u>Please note: this is a one-time collection. We will not be collecting these items throughout Advent as we have in the past.</u>**

St. Nicholas' Helpers: Gather up your older kids or bring a friend and help behind the scenes with the collections for St. Dominic's and Mary's Children. Helpers are needed before each of the Sunday Masses December 11 and 12 to sort and move donated items to the Fr. Mikus Hall. Volunteers with larger vehicles and others to help load donated items are needed Monday morning, December 13, to make the deliveries to St. Dominic's in Detroit or to Mary's Children in Clawson. Volunteers are also needed on December 15 to deliver the Giving Tree gifts to the Macomb County Community Mental Health office in Mt. Clemens. A little bit of your time will go a long way toward helping the parish deliver Christmas to local people in need. Slovak Seminarian Sponsorship: Since its foundation, our parish has been blessed with the generous pastoral care of priests from Slovakia. This project gives us an opportunity to show our appreciation to the Slovak Bishops for their continued support of Ss. Cyril & Methodius and to help build the Church in Slovakia. Currently 24 men are in priestly formation. You can help cover their fees and expenses with a **gift of \$300**. If you would like to sponsor the seminary, please contact *Sandi Brady* in the Parish Office. You will receive a Christmas ornament with the photo of one of the seminarians to place in your home as a reminder to pray for him.

Christian Service Fund: Donations made to the parish Christian Service Fund during Advent will be divided among Catholic Charities' Senior Outreach Program and Image of God Crisis Pregnancy Centers. You can contribute to this fund online using PushPay or place a check made out to *Ss. Cyril & Methodius* in a white Advent giving envelope and put it in the collection basket by December 25, 2021.

Senior Outreach: When the Covid shutdown occurred, **Catholic Charities of Southeast Michigan** started a new initiative to deliver groceries to low-income seniors and people with disabilities. They discovered homebound individuals and couples who had struggled to get groceries prior to the pandemic. Because of this, the initiative is now a continuing program with volunteers delivering groceries, incontinence items, and cleaning products to 600 individuals in the tri-county area. A monetary donation to this program will help buy a commercial freezer so meat can be purchased in larger quantities (and lower prices), frozen, and stored until it can be delivered to clients. Any additional donations will help buy a refrigerator, and incontinence and cleaning products. Image of God Crisis Pregnancy Centers: For many years, these four centers have quietly and consistently been a haven sharing God's love for local pregnant women in crisis and in need. The centers provide free pregnancy tests and ultrasounds, maternity clothes, parenting classes, baby clothing, and baby furniture and supplies. Just as important, the staff offers loving counsel and guidance to help young mothers with life goals like finishing their education, building better relationships, developing a spiritual life, or finding a job. Donations to Image of God CPC will help meet essential costs, such as rent and utilities, so all four centers can continue serving women and babies in 2022.
