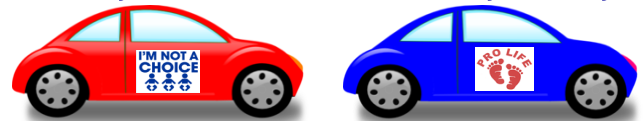

Dear Ss. Cyril and Methodius Parish,
