SECOND DAY: Prayer for Hope *(August 28—Feast Day of St. Augustine)*

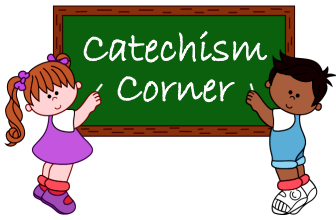

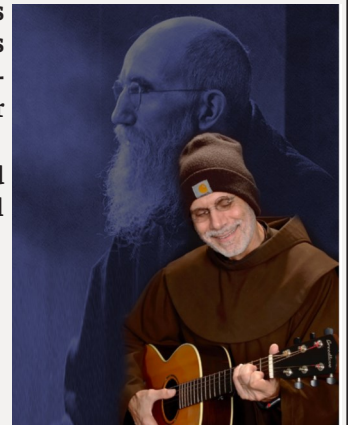
