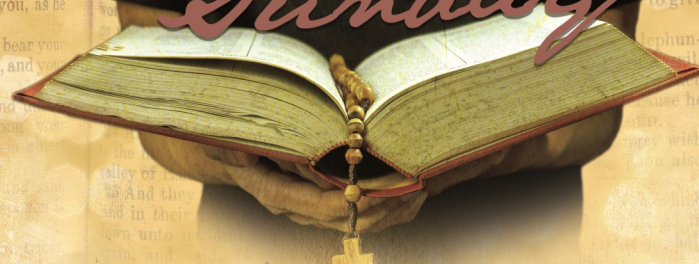

This extraordinary depiction of Blessed Solanus Casey will be performed Ss. Cyril & Methodius in the Fr. Mikus Hall on:

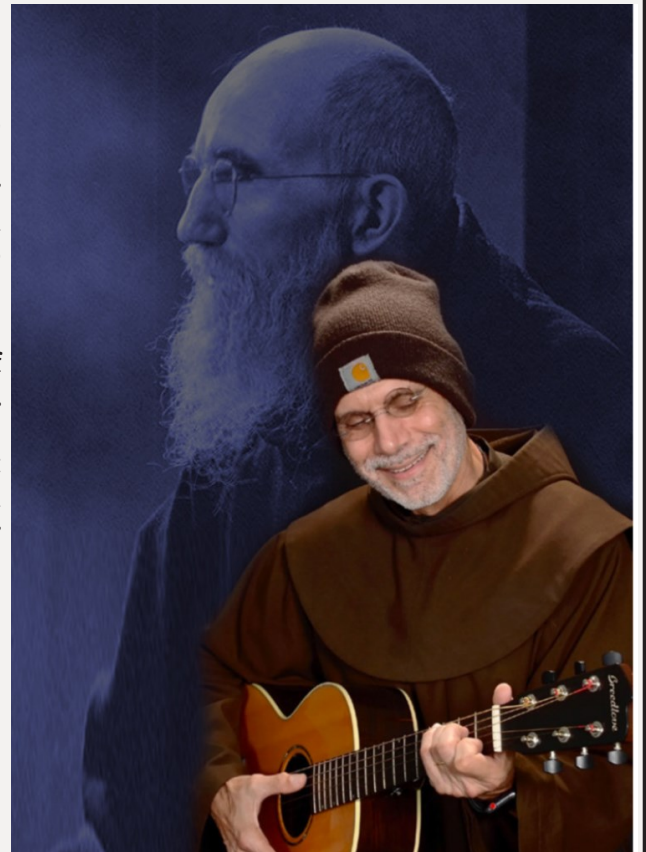
