The Knights of Columbus (Council 7011) is pleased to announce our 2025 Prolife Poster -Contest. The following is a summary of the Terms and Conditions of this contest:

Guidelines:

CONTEST FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS CAN BE OBTAINED FROM YOUR YOUTH GROUP LEADER OR FROM THE PARISH OFFICE.

- Contest is open to all students in grade levels indicated below.
- Posters must reflect the assigned theme and topic, be appropriate and in good taste, be the student's original work and be submitted by the published deadline. Please be sure the paint and colors are dry and all items are properly secured on the poster.
- Posters must be maximum size of 11 inches by 14 inches. Posters must be made of a material which is easy to either fold or roll up so as to fit on the bus to Washington for those going to the March for Life in January, 2025.
- Acceptable media: crayons, colored pencils, ink, collage (pictures from photos, media, or internet to demonstrate contest theme) or paint.
- The student's name, grade, contact and other required information should appear only on the separate Essay Contest form (attached) which should be taped to the back of the poster. Name must NOT appear on the front of the poster.

- All entries will be returned at the Awards Ceremony on January 19, 2025 at 3 P M so as to enable students to take them on the March for Life in Washington in January, 2024. Any pictures and/or videos taken by the Knights of Columbus (Council 7011) can be used by the Knights for their purposes.

Judges will be selected by Council 7011. Council members, clergy, teachers, and other members of the community may serve as judges.

- Posters will be judged on a 60-point scoring system as follows...

20 points: Content as to how clearly the theme is presented.

20 points: Originality

20 points: Overall effect

Council 7011 is the sponsor of this contest and the Grand Knight of Council 7011 or his designate is the official responsible for this contest.

Awards:

Awards will be grouped as follows...

- Group 1- Grades 7-8
- Group 2-Grades 9-10
- Group 3-Grades 11-12

Awards will be as follows... For each of the above groups,

- \$100 cash - first prize
- \$50 cash - second prize
- \$20 gift certificate to Faith @ Work - third prize
- All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation.

Posters will be judged and awards will be presented on **Sunday January 19, from 3-5 P.M. at St. Cyrils Hall.** Posters will be returned to the students at that time so as to enable them to take them to the March for Life in Washington Friday January 24, 2025.
