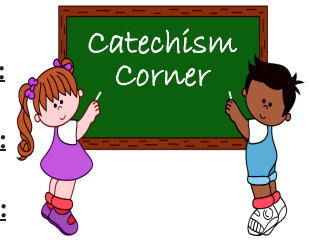

Northland Pro-Life Prayer News

What mixed emotions we have when reflecting on Calendar Year 2022. While the Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade, we've seen the abortion issue returned to the states - some have imposed restrictions, while others, including Michigan, have opted for more liberal laws. We pray that Our Lord enlightens us all to the sanctity of life from conception to natural death and that we come together to support expectant parents, as well as those who have lost children (born or unborn).

Please join us for the following Pro-Life events:

- A Pro-Life rosary is prayed each Saturday at church. The Joyful and Luminous Mysteries are prayed before Mass, starting at 8:10AM, and the Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries are prayed after the 9:00M Mass, starting around 9:45AM.
- The monthly prayer and witness event outside the Northland Family Planning Clinic, 3810 17 Mile Road (just west of Ryan Road), takes place on First Saturdays from 11:30AM to 12:30PM. Bring your friends, family, and rosary. Park in the shopping center lots nearby - no parking is allowed at the clinic. Prayer events usually last around an hour, but they may be shortened due to the weather, and you can also pray from your car.

Women and Families in Need

Abortion is now legal in Michigan at an unprecedented level and the Archdiocese of Detroit is committed to accompanying women and families in need, with greater resolve than ever. In the AOD, we do this largely through Catholic Charities of Southeast Michigan, our charitable arm, and through the Archdiocese's Evangelization and Missionary Discipleship Department. In particular, *Walking with Moms in Need* (WWMIN) is a ministry to help parishioners identify and create local resources that provide assistance to pregnant and parenting moms in need, and Project Rachel is an important ministry for individuals who have been harmed by abortion.

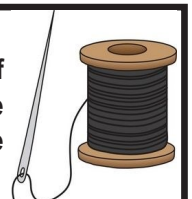
Rosary Society Artifacts

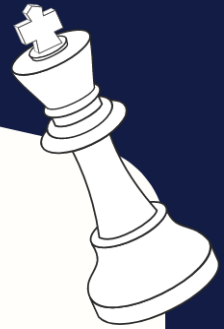

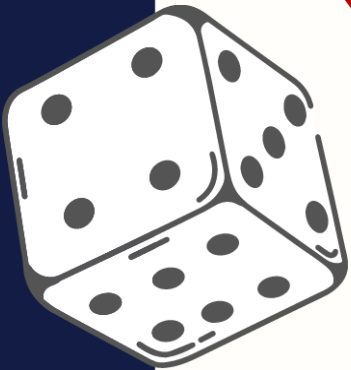
