



Northland Family Prayer News • First Saturday, October 7

While it is sometimes difficult to share pro-life views with others, we pray that Our Lord and Our Lady will help us reach those in need and help us to persevere in times of difficulty. Please join us for the following events:

The next prayer and witness event outside the Northland Family Planning Clinic, 3810 17 Mile (just west of Ryan Road), takes place Saturday, October 7, from 11:30AM to 12:30PM. Bring your friends, family, rosary and weather gear. Park in the shopping center lots nearby - parking is not allowed at the clinic. The prayer event lasts about an hour and is not usually cancelled - you can also pray nearby from your car.

The 40 Days for Life campaign encourages people to pray, fast and, if possible, be a peaceful witness for life outside of abortion facilities. The campaign runs daily through November 5. See: www.40daysforlife.com for more information.

A Pro-Life rosary is usually prayed each Saturday at church. The Joyful and Luminous Mysteries are prayed before Mass, starting at 8:10AM, and the Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries are prayed after 9AM Mass, starting around 9:45AM.
