



We often fool ourselves. We believe we are better than what we really are. We'll often times compare our living and ways of life according to worldly expectations instead of God's. If we're not murderers, rapists, perpetual thieves, or drunkards, we tend to think we have it pretty much all together. We'll believe that as long as we're not illustrious sinners and perform the occasional good deed we're okay.

This way of thinking is demonic. Satan wants us in sin just enough to have it control us, even if the sin(s) aren't terribly recognizable. As long as we continue to live to the world's standard of sin we're doomed.

The spiritual masters of the Church and our Lord remind us that the first step in overcoming sin and living according to truh (the right standard created by God) is to have knowledge of self and knowledge of God. This is our goal. This is the standard we want to achieve in order to unite ourselves more fully to God and the Eucharistic Lord. If we would take Christ Jesus as seriously as we do our finances, our well-being, our careers, our our children's security and safety, we would see Christianity lived out in a completely new and spectacular way.

Always remember what our Lord commanded us: "Seek <u>first</u> His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things (what I mentioned above) shall be yours a well." (Matthew 6:33) We have a lot of work to do. But He promised to supply us with all we need.
