For the past seven years the St. Nicholas Council #7011 has conducted our popular annual Baby Bottle Campaign in support of Knights of Columbus' national Right to Life initiatives, hosted by our supporting parish, Ss. Cyril & Methodius Slovak Catholic Church.

St. Nicholas Council has raised and donated a total of more than \$66,000 over these past seven years, including \$ 11,000 for 2024, matched by funding from the Supreme Council of the Knights of Columbus, to Mary's Mantle and several other recipient organizations across the Detroit Metropolitan area. These funds go toward facility improvements, operating costs, expansions, and new equipment.

From Mary's Mantle's mission statement: "Mary's Mantle is a Catholic residential program for homeless expectant women. We witness the love of Christ by promoting the dignity of life. We provide a safe, faith-based, and caring environment that supports the transition into motherhood, including extended aftercare for

continued personal growth and integration into the community. We focus on the spiritual, emotional, physical, educational, and vocational well-being of mother and child."

"These lifesaving donations could never have been achieved without the generous love and support of the parishioners of Ss. Cyril & Methodius parish. When the need is greatest, as it is now, we can always count on our neighbors and friends at St. Cyril's to open their hearts and wallets and help us help others," said Gino Vitale, St. Nicholas Council's Right to Life Chair.

Keeping with the theme of sin, it would do us well to remember that whoever overlooks little things, will gradually fail in great ones; and, having gotten used to thinking everything is little we will resort to thinking all is still well. We then slowly begin to commit great sins despite the uneasiness of our conscience. We might find it exciting or invigorating to step to the edge of the cliff, but what will come to pass is that, with one footstep, we will fall headfirst unto our demise. Beware, therefore, of venial sins, lest you fall into mortal sins. As long as we give way to even the smallest of sins, we set our soul in danger. We oftentimes underestimate our own weaknesses and overestimate our strengths. Think of our Lord Jesus, His unspeakable passion with all the anguish that it brought Him for our atonement, so that we may feel eager to expiate for our mortal sins that we have committed. However, with the small offenses we commit, we load His Heart with bitterness and afflict It with continued sorrows. It's much like a loved one continuing to act in a way which contradicts their claims of your love yet doesn't go overboard. We must consider again and again what we are doing throughout our days. We may inflict a small wound upon His Heart and out-of-the-blue we deliver Him a mortal blow. So is the human heart. More people fear more to offend the meanest of persons instead of God, Who is all loving and merciful. Already we can tell something is not right with this picture.

- ◆ The Parishioner rate is available to families in the Good Shepherd Family of Parishes.
- ◆ Unfortunately, due to limited room availability, registered parishioners will be placed first. Non-registered parishioners will be placed if room is available. Family must be registered for 6 months before they are eligible for parishioner rate. Non-parishioners must supply letter from their pastor giving permission for them to attend St. Cyril's Catechism Program.
- ◆ The ideal method of payment is online through parish's Pushpay. Please be sure to select the drop-down for Religious Education and include the date, receipt number and authorization code on your registration form in the upper LEFT-hand corner. Don't forget to include the medical and media forms with the registration form in your envelope.
- ◆ If necessary, tuition may be paid by check (payable to Ss. Cyril & Methodius) and mailed with all registration, media, and medical forms to the church address, Attn. Paul or Carroll Schuller.
- ◆ If there are any question about eligibility or tuition costs, please contact *Paul or Carroll Schuller*.

Homeschool Program

- ◆ Only those who are homeschooled for other academics and active members in our church may homeschool for Religious Education.
- ◆ Home School students making the Sacrament of COMMUNION in 2025 must enroll at this time.
- ◆ Home School students making the Sacrament of CONFIRMATION in 2025 (8th grade) and 2026 (7th grade) must enroll at this time. The Confirmation Program is a two-year program. You must be enrolled both years to be eligible.
- ◆ KINDERGARTNERS: There is a \$20 supply fee and must be age of five by December 1st, 2024.

Registration Directions

- ◆ When completing the forms, keep in mind that you need to note the grade of your child for the next school year (2024-2025).
 1. Print clearly all family information or review all information if your form came preprinted.
 2. Fill out Media Form and list all your students under Name – example: John, Mary & Ann Smith
 3. Fill out Medical Form in its entirety and if possible include copy of medical card.
