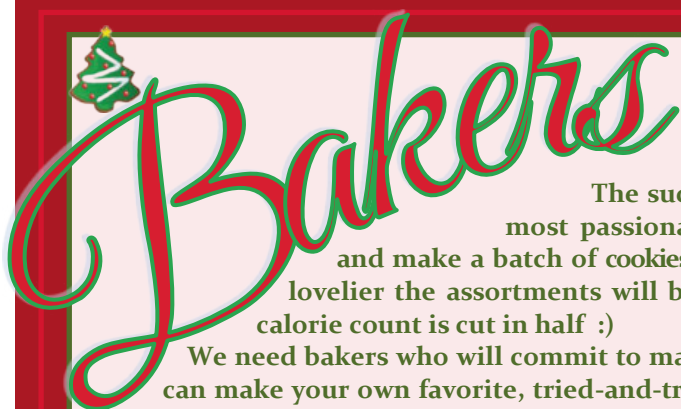

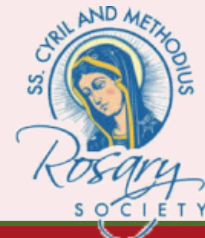

The more we have this sorrow given through the Heart of God the more perfect our contrition will be, even if we don't necessarily feel any different. The more sincerely we confess our sins, with an upright heart, the more certain we can be certain that our sins have been forgiven and the more secure we will feel against sinning in the future or committing new sins. We have a sure mark of sorrow for the sins of our past if we abstain from committing new ones. Therefore, obtain within you, and preserve always, a firm resolve of casting out whatever you know to be displeasing to God, and of suffering all evils of this life, than to commit a voluntary sin. We live in a society where what is sinful is considered okay, or at best acceptable. It's taken far too lightly. Yet our decisions, determination, and honesty will determine where we'll spend eternity. The choice is yours.
