### **Investiture of the Miraculous Medal**

**Saturday, November 23**

At her apparition to Sister Catherine Laboure, Holy Mary expressed that all of her children wear the Miraculous Medal. Initially it was called the Medal of the Immaculate Conception, but because of the many miracles attributed to Our Lady through the medal, it became known as the Miraculous Medal. One wears the medal as a sign of love and fidelity to Our Blessed Mother. One must not think of it as a good luck charm or a rabbit's foot. Our Lady promised great graces to all who ask for them with confidence.

A plenary indulgence is obtained on the day of investiture if properly disposed. A plenary indulgence may be obtained once a day and may be applied to yourself or a deceased individual or to the souls in purgatory (never for another living individual other than yourself).

The Investiture will take place next Saturday, November 23, after the 5:30PM Holy Mass. If you would like to be invested, please pick up a packet with the novena, a Miraculous Medal, a blue ribbon and other information in the Parish Office. Please bring the medal with the blue ribbon threaded into it at the time of the Investiture.

We request that you fill out the form (found in your packet) with your name and contact information (email, telephone number and address) and leave it in the Parish Office. Please join our Prayer Force that we can call upon for prayers when the need arises.

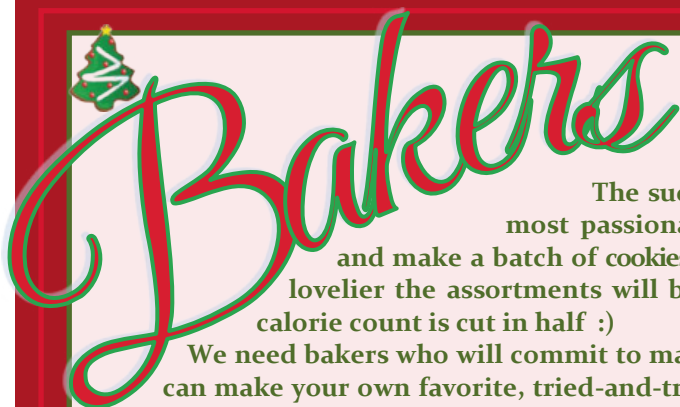
**Eucharistic Adoration ~ Hearts Deepest Longing**

We were discussing our resolve to take God seriously when it comes to our sins. Far too often today sin is minimized. It no longer holds the weight it once did or how it ought to be. Sin is no longer a word used in describing bad moral behavior or the disordered use of God's gifts. For fear of being labeled as judgmental or self-righteous many have passively allowed the destruction of others and society as a whole. Nevertheless, God means business and takes sin very seriously. We ought to as well; before God and with ourselves. We must pay close attention so as not to deceive ourselves. We cannot pretend that any casual form of resolve will be sufficient to cleanse and heal us. A half-hearted desire is not enough. A resolution made because of custom, for reputation, or for a specific purpose other than to show God you are truly sorry for offending Him and Him alone. It's a real battle within us; to will and not to will. We may desire to sin no more but we will refuse the means to help us not to sin anymore. It is of the utmost importance, then, that we be really sincere and settled that we WILL use the means (grace) to aid us in not committing sin. We must keep this resolve alive and active every day. We must renew it through prayer and following our spiritual exercises. By doing this we will be given special graces to know ourselves and our sinful tendencies and be better equipped to do battle against them.

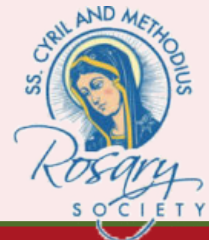

**Dear Parents:** On Tuesday, December 24, there will be a CHRISTMAS EVE HOLY MASS, at 4:00PM, with a Living Nativity and Children/Youth Choir. All Ss. Cyril and Methodius parishioners, Religious Education, EDGE and N.O.W. Students (Grade K-12) are invited and encouraged to participate in the Living Nativity, Choir, or in any other capacity listed. Practice dates are December 7, 14 & 21 from 12:00PM - 2:00PM. A sign-up sheet is below. This form must be signed by a parent and returned to the Parish Office, your student's Catechism Teacher or Youth Minister **no later than November 30**. Keep in mind that there is no Catechism on November 28 so if you are going to turn the form in at a class, it must be done on November 20th. Due to the size of our congregation and the limited number of parts in the Nativity, consideration of LEAD ROLES will be on a FIRST COME BASIS ONLY. It is very important to return the forms as soon as possible. There is also a need for Parent and Teen volunteers. I WILL NOT call each student regarding the chosen roles to play. Please have them attend the first rehearsal if they are signed up to participate. Students must attend at least two rehearsals (December 7, 14 & 21). We cannot accept students who only attend the last rehearsal.

**PARENTS/TEENS:** A few volunteers are needed to assist with the children and set-up/clean-up as needed. We also hand out the bells at the 4:00PM Holy Mass and would love to continue this beautiful tradition. Parents/Teens normally assemble the bells during rehearsals. Seamstresses/Costume help is also needed. Many of our costumes and things are in great disrepair and it would be so awesome to have assistance with mending and sorting costumes. This is a good opportunity for 8th Grade Confirmation Students to get Service Hours.
