



Eucharistic Adoration HEART'S DEEPEST LONGING

The sixth thing we can do to understand, recognize God's will for our lives and to deepen our intimacy with Him is to consecrate ourselves to Him through Our Lady. Devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary in its many forms serves to increase our connection with God. After all, out of all creation who knows Jesus more than His own Mother? Who

is Jesus more likely to listen to and act in obedience to than Mary, His Mother who does His will perfectly? The process is simple. Have the desire, choose a Marian Feast Day which you feel close to, prepare according to how the saints (normally St. Louis de Montfort), and upon the Feast day of your choice, make the consecration with all honesty and sincerity. As one who made his consecration in 2013, Ican attest to its fruitfulness in my own spiritual life after these past twelve years. One act of the consecration is to freely hand over to Mary our wills to mold into that of the Divine Will. Our spiritual eyes will be enlightened, we will see the things happening in the spirit more clearly, and learning the faith becomes simpler. She will "mother" us when we need someone and no one is there. She will protect us from the evil spirits in times of temptation and otherwise. Those who are consecrated to Jesus through Mary will always be safe. It should be known, however, that to the degree we take her seriously the more she takes us seriously. If we give her a little, we receive a little. If we give a lot, we receive a lot. This time-tested consecration has made saints out - Paul A. Ray of ordinary people.



Calling All Parishioners! Fish Frys Begin Friday, March 7 The Knights Need your Help Once Again This Lent!




