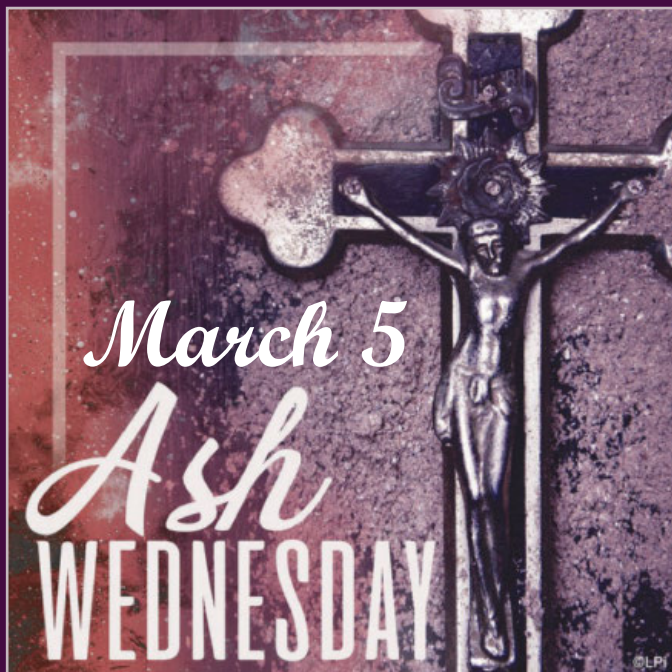

WHAT IS LENT?

The 40-day period from Ash Wednesday and before Easter Sunday. It is marked by **praying, fasting, abstinence and other acts of penance.**

WHAT IS FASTING?

One meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed one full meal.

DAYS OF FAST?

Ash Wednesday • Good Friday

WHO ARE REQUIRED TO FAST?

Catholics from age <18 to 59>. The sick are excused from fasting.

WHAT IS ABSTINENCE?

Abstinence is **refraining from eating meat**. Meat is considered to be the flesh and organs of mammals and fowl.

DAYS OF ABSTINENCE?

Ash Wednesday • All Fridays in Lent • Good Friday

WHO ARE REQUIRED TO ABSTAIN?

Mandatory for everyone older than 14 years old.

HEART'S DEEPEST LONGING

The seventh aspect on our part to help us determine what God wants for us is to pray the Holy Rosary daily. I know the first thing that comes to mind is "How? My days are already so busy I don't have the time to devote to praying the entire Holy Rosary every day" or we'll try to rationalize our way out of it by saying something like, "I just get to distracted when praying the Rosary, my mind wanders and I can't focus." What's important to realize here is it isn't what we feel or if we'll find time, but the intent of the heart. If we choose to pray anyway even if we're super busy or fear being distracted it shows God we want to be closer to Him even though we recognize our weaknesses and limitations. Pray anyway. If you can only take one decade at a time, that's okay. Pick the others up later. If your mind wanders keep on praying anyway.

St. Louis de Montfort said, "No one has ever prayed the perfect Rosary." So many saints, including St. Padre Pio, St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. Bernard of Clairvaux, and others, have expressed the power contained within the Holy Rosary. Our Lady, in her apparitions has continually told us to pray the Rosary daily that people may repent and turn back to God and disaster be avoided. It is the "Prayer of the Gospels". Satan and his demons shutter in fear when the Holy Rosary is said authentically. There is nothing left to be desired. Outside of the Holy Mass and The Lord's Prayer, the Rosary is the greatest of all prayers. Why NOT pray it as often as possible! Working along with the other aspects of discovering (discerning) God's will for us (His very own will), the Holy Rosary will put us on the fast track to holiness.

Thank you so much for continuing to pray for your baby. By the end of the sixth month (also the end of 2nd trimester), the baby will be 14 inches in length and weigh 1.5 to 2 pounds. The baby sits up straight now to accommodate its internal organs that have moved to their final place. The baby is regulating its own temperature because both oil and sweat glands are functioning. A waxy white film layer covers the baby protecting its skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid. This film layer is like a natural cream that will be absorbed at birth. The baby now responds to sounds, and its lungs are fairly well developed. Chances of survival are good if born now.
