

Eucharistic Adoration HEART'S DEEPEST LONGING

We've come to the halfway point in our journey to help us discover God's will in our lives. These suggestions are meant to be a guide to show us what we can do in our lives to live the Divine Will in all that we do. This week's suggestion is to attend Holy Mass and receive the Eucharist every day, if possible. Like praying the Holy Rosary every day, going to Mass every day of the week brings with us the question of timing. We live in a time that is saturated with things consuming our time. Whether it is through work or leisure, each day is a challenge for things we pay attention to. Taking into account the difference between the married and unmarried, St. Paul advises us the following: "Are you bound to a wife? Do not seek to be free. Are you free from a wife (husband included)? Do not seek marriage...those who marry will have worldly troubles, and I would spare you that...I want you to be free from anxieties. The unmarried man (or woman) is anxious about the affairs of the Lord, how to please the Lord; but the married man is anxious about worldly affairs, how to please his wife, and his interests are divided (1 Cor. 7:27, 32-34)". With this in mind we can see it would be more challenging for those married to attend Mass every day than those who are unmarried; especially if children are involved. Mass is where we receive the graces needed to remain a soldier for Christ, and to maintain a healthy, solid and stable marriage. It may be impossible to go every day, but attending Mass as often as possible is the medicine we need for living in the age in which we live. The more graces we have, the better. - Paul A. Ray
