

Eucharistic Adoration Heart's Deepest Longing

Today, Sunday, April 27, is Divine Mercy Sunday. A relatively new Feast Day in the Liturgical Calendar. It was instituted by Pope St. John Paul II on April 30, 2000, at the canonization of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska. It was through St. Faustina that our Lord

revealed devotion to His Divine Mercy in the 1930's. To explain what makes Divine Mercy Sunday so special let's hear the words of our Lord which He told to St. Faustina when requesting this Feast Day to be celebrated: "My daughter, tell the whole world about *My* inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. Mt mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Divine Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy." (Diary 699) Divine Mercy is an extension of devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, a Feast which is devoted to the love of God for us. These words are true and trustworthy. Take full advantage! You'll experience peace and love on a level you've never known before, we just have to make our move, Jesus made His! -Paul A. Rav

Total Consecration to Jesus thru Mary Begins April 28 Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary • May 31

Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary is a beautiful exercise to increase our spirituality and ability to truly serve our Lord Jesus Christ. The basic premise set forth by St. Louis Marie de Montfort is simply that Jesus came into the world through Mary and that for us to always be assured of being close to Jesus, even closer than ever before, we should go through Mary. St. Louis de Montfort (1673 – 1716) developed a 33-day devotion consisting of various prayers and readings to help us to grow in holiness and increase our faith and love for our Lord. It will help us to detach ourselves from the world and bond ourselves more closely with Christ through the example and intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Consecration to Jesus is for anyone, who is old enough to understand the love of Jesus and Mary. The preparation is intended to prepare our hearts and minds by praying and meditating.

The next preparation begins this Monday, April 28, for all who wish to make, or renew their Consecration on May 31, the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. *"Preparation for Total Consecration"* books are available in the parish office for \$10.


