



### Eucharistic Adoration Heart's Deepest Longing

We continue in our learning how to live in the Divine Will this week by concentrating on prayer. Our next area of guidance is to **spend at least 15 minutes per day in mental prayer.** To define what mental prayer is it is the form of prayer in which the sentiments expressed are one's own



and not those of another person and the expression of these sentiments is mainly, if not entirely, interior and not externalized. In other words, mental prayer is prayer to God in our own words and not set-prayers such as the Hail Mary or Our Father. It is through mental prayer where we really get to know the Heart of God because we're talking to Him with our own mind and words; just as we talk with other people in our lives, but on a much deeper, intimate level. I prefer to look at it as "Having coffee with Jesus". It is much like how we'll sit down with a good friend with a cup of coffee and engage in a meaningful conversation. Need I remind you that Jesus is alive and with us? Treat Him as such! The Second Person of the Blessed Trinity IS a person after all. By immersing yourself in mental prayer you can talk to God freely and openly. He loves you and it's most dear to His Heart when His children talk to Him. After all, He is our Father! Never fear approaching Him in this way; He already knows your heart and has always been with you. Nothing you pray/say will surprise Him because He knows you. You could even read Scripture while praying and ask God questions or seek clarity while you read. The sole purpose is to know God on a deeper level and you will quickly begin to see His Will in your life for direction and love. -Paul A. Rav




