



#### **Eucharistic Adoration Heart's Deepest Longing**

We come to the 16th aspect of our journey in finding God's will in our lives: do some spiritual reading every day. The amount is up to you, however, the more time you spend the better off you will be. There will never be shortage of material to dig into. Sacred Scripture holds precedence as we know so the Bible ought to be the first thing we read. The Church has even given readings every day in the Holy Mass which we can read any time of day on our own if we can't make it to Mass. The Office of Readings in the Breviary (The Divine Office) has selected readings for us from Scripture and the Church. These, too, can be read at any time a day. Or simply take up your Bible and start reading! The Catechism of the Catholic Church gives us a rundown of all that the Church teaches and is the greatest companion to the Bible. We have the Lives of the Saints to read and the actual writings of the saints and other Church documents throughout its 2000 year existence. There are books on apologetics (how to defend what we believe), about the Sacraments, about the spiritual life, about history. The topics are endless. We live in such a time where technology has allowed us to read most of this material online or using apps. Support your local Catholic bookstore and go there so often they'll know you by name! Read a little here, a little there, or simply grab some coffee, tea or beverage of your choice and sit back comfortably and crack open that book you've been meaning to read for the longest time. The bottom line is if the only Catholicism we get to know comes from one hour at Mass on Sunday, we do ourselves a great disservice. We have to take the ball and run with it ourselves, on our own. The greatest way to know the voice of God and thus knowing His will for our lives is to get to know Him, and we get to know Him mainly through what He wrote us and those who followed Him and came before us. -Paul A. 
