

Eucharistic Adoration Heart's Deepest Longing

We come to our final aspect of learning God's will in our lives: making your home a holy place. As a Catholic, when someone comes into our home they should immediately know that we're Catholic. This doesn't mean our rooms need to be floor-to-ceiling marked with Catholic paintings, photos, statues, prayers, crucifixes,

etc. Our homes are not a church after all. However, a crucifix, a picture of our Lord and our Lady, or specific devotionals we hold dear to us ought to be placed in a predominate place in our homes. These serve as reminders of who we are and what our lives revolve around. It shows us, and others, what's most important in life. Much like we keep photos of loved ones throughout the house we cannot leave out He who made it all possible. We should have reminders of our patron saints in the house, or perhaps an angel or a scene from Scripture. Holy Water dispensers on the side of doors (not all doors but those used to go in and out of our homes or in our bedrooms), are also great for extra spiritual protection at home. We should have our homes blessed by a priest or bishop often. Some people have even created a corner of one of their rooms to dedicate as a shrine for prayer, meditation, and reflection, complete with a kneeler, prayer book and Sacred Scripture. We should allow our house to be a witness to Jesus Christ itself. With this being said, we conclude our journey through things we ought to do if we seriously desire to follow the will of God in our lives. Next week's column will be a recap of all 18 aspects. 

The Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) campaign has officially launched for 2025. Last year, for the first time in several years, we CATHOLIC SERVICES APPEAL not only met our goal of \$96,611

but exceeded it by \$4.823. Thank you to everyone who made this possible through your generous donations.

The CSA collection continues to fund many diocesan-wide projects and services that benefit all parishes and help to spread the faith. CSA funds are used to fund the seminary, immigration legal services for clergy, parish services which supports our parish in many ways, youth ministry support services, Pro-Life ministries and so much more. CSA not only supports the Archdiocese, but provides for services that our parish could not survive without. Our contribution to the CSA makes a difference in the lives of many people and is also a great way to strengthen the parish finances. Our goal for 2025 is \$90,729.

Just a reminder that if we are able to exceed the goal, anything collected for CSA over and above the \$90,729 will be returned to the parish without being charged the 7% Archdiocesan Assessment Fee that normal donations are charged. If we do not meet the goal the parish must pay for the remaining balance out of savings that has already been assessed the 7% fee.

The Archdiocese of Detroit did a direct mailing campaign on the parishes' behalf once again so most of you should have already received that. The direct mailing from, and the handling of the majority of payments by, the AOD takes much of the burden of administration off the parish.

If you do not receive a packet in the mail from the Archdiocese you can call (800) 348-2886, go online to givecsa.org/cyril-andmethodius, use the QR code below to donate or go to our parish website and select "give" in the top right corner followed by the red "Give to CSA" button. After several complaints from donors over the last couple of years the Archdiocese changed the website they use for CSA giving so you will notice a difference from the previous years. When filling out the form please fill out as much of the information as you have available, but only the

fields with the red asterisks are required. You can also use the green envelope in the May/June donation envelope packets or write a check to "Archdiocese of Detroit-CSA and drop it in the collection basket.
