

Catholic Services Appeal

The Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) campaign has officially launched for 2025. Last year, for the first time in several years, we not only met our goal of \$96,611 but exceeded it by \$4,823. Thank you to everyone who made this possible.

The CSA collection continues to fund many diocesan-wide projects and services that benefit all parishes and help to spread the faith. CSA not only supports the Archdiocese, but provides for services that our parish could not survive without. Our contribution to the CSA makes a difference in the lives of many people and is also a great way to strengthen the parish finances.

Our goal for 2025 is \$90,729. Just a reminder that if we are able to exceed the goal, anything collected for CSA over and above the \$90,729 will be returned to the parish without being charged the 7% Archdiocesan Assessment Fee that normal donations are charged. If we do not meet the goal the parish must pay for the remaining balance out of savings that has already been assessed the 7% fee.

The Archdiocese of Detroit did a direct mailing campaign on the parishes' behalf once again so most of you should have already received that. The direct mailing from, and the handling of the majority of payments by, the AOD takes much of the burden of administration off the parish.

If you do not receive a packet in the mail from the Archdiocese you can call (800) 348-2886, go online to givecsa.org/cyril-and-methodius, use the QRcode below to donate or go to our parish website and select "give" in the top right corner followed by the red "Give to CSA" button. After several complaints from donors over the last couple of years the Archdiocese changed the website they use for CSA giving so you will notice a difference from the previous years. When filling out the form please fill out as much of the information as you have available, but only the fields with the red

asterisks are required. You can also use the green envelope in the May/June donation envelope packets or write a check to "Archdiocese of Detroit-CSA and drop it in the collection basket.

"The Face of Jesus" Movie ONE DAY ONLY • Thursday, June 26

Synopsis: Can we see the face of the invisible God? Do we know what our Savior looked like? The film *The Face of Jesus* explores two acheiropoietic images—sacred cloths not made by human hands—the Shroud of Turin and the Veil of Manoppello, as well as the most extraordinary depiction of Jesus painted

by human hands: the Vilnius image of the Merciful Jesus. Filmmakers take the audience on a cinematic journey to the tomb in Jerusalem from 2,000 years ago, to Rome, Manoppello, and San Giovanni Rotondo, to discover what our Savior looked like. After the main feature, learn about the devotion to the Holy Face with a bonus featuring U.S. clergy (Fr. Robert Altier and Fr. Lawrence Daniel Carney III) who detail the power of the ancient devotion and why it's gaining traction among the faithful in modern times.

Eucharistic Adoration Heart's Deepest Longing

We have closed our walk through the simple things we can all do to live in the Divine Will. Each of the subjects was discussed in previous articles. Here is the complete list of the topics (things we can do) to learn the will of God in and for our lives and to remain in continual friendship with Him (State of Grace)



- 1. Strive to be in continuous conversation with Jesus; all day, every day
- 2. Strive to do everything as an Act in the Divine Will
- 3. Ask God for the gift of living in the Divine Will everyday
- 4. Grow in virtue every day. Live the Beatitudes, be a saint!
- 5. Spread knowledge of the Divine Will
- 6. Consecrate yourself to Jesus through Mary
- 7. Pray the Holy Rosary every day
- 8. Wear a crucifix, Miraculous Medal, and Brown Scapular
- 9. Attend Holy Mass and receive Communion every day (if possible)
- 10. Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet every day
- 11. Go to Confession at least once a month
- 12. Never waste suffering. Embrace every cross God sends you
- 13. Make sure you are doing every day works of mercy
- 14. Do a daily or weekly Holy Hour
- 15. Try to set aside at least 15 minutes per day (1% of your day) for mental prayer
- 16. Do Spiritual Reading every day; Scripture, the Catechism, writings of Saints, Church documents, etc.
- 17. Fast each Wednesday and Friday as you feel called
- 18. Ensure that your home is a Holy place

Even keeping a quarter of these things can work wonders! But it's ultimately up to you. The more we give to God, the more He'll grant us in return. If we give a little, we'll receive little; if we give a lot, we will receive a lot. It's all up to you!
