MASS or EUCHARISTIC LITURGY daily at 9:00AM (Parent must stay with the child at Mass. Mass is not required but highly encouraged. Have your children ever taken up the offertory gifts? If not, let me know?)

VBS RUNS from 10:00AM - 1:00PM daily!

DROP OFF your child/children each day in the Gallery no earlier than 9:45AM.

PICK UP your child/children in the Fr. Mikus Hall promptly at 1:00PM. Parents are encouraged to join us for our closing assembly at 12:50PM. Allow a half hour for pick-up due to many kids being at camp this week.

Eucharistic Adoration Heart's Deepest Longing

We continue this week in our look into the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We have to be blunt: if we freely choose not to confess our sins or believe we do not require confession, we immediately set our hearts on hell and abandon our salvation. How do we handle this temptation? Just consider the greatness of our punishment. God will not forgive a sin that is not confessed. We can listen to deception of our enemy and agree not to think about it, but our conscience will always trigger us to move in one way or another. If you are embarrassed or ashamed or worry what the priest might think of you, remember that God knows your faults already. The priest cannot send a soul to hell, God can. Consider the freedom you will receive the moment you hear the words of absolution. When walking out of the confessional think about how you are perfect just as you were the moment you were baptized! Think of the clean slate you have been given and your conscience is now quiet. The evil spirits flee and you receive power from on high! Why, someone may ask, does anyone reject or prefer not to go to confession? Speaking from experience I have never had a bad experience during confession. The mercy of God is simple and loving; it is gentle and so willing to forgive. Even when I worried myself about what the priest might think it quickly vanishes like it was never even there. Such is the love of the Heart of Christ!

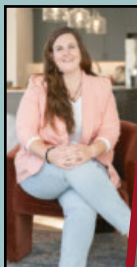
