



#### Eucharistic Adoration Heart's Deepest Longing

Moving ahead in our look into the Sacrament of Reconciliation I cannot help but stress how we have a tendency to confess our sins candidly, yet wonder why our lives don't change. Some approach the Sacrament from necessity, others through human respect, and others again from a certain custom. Why wonder, then, if they that approach in this

manner derive from it but little or no fruit? If we approached each of our confessions as if it were our last we would then experience the lasting and sweet effects from it. We have to realize each time we walk into the confessional that our salvation is on the line. Yet nevertheless, how often do we end up confessing the same faults over and over again even after resolving not to fall into such temptations again? We are fickle creatures of habit, and our fallen nature has no mercy. Through all of this do not lose heart. Your first step in overcoming is simply recognizing the problem exists; it is an act of the Holy Spirit. We must pray for, and cultivate, a true firm purpose of amendment. We must first desire change. With no desire, the sin will never go away. However, by no means never neglect going to confession. The greatest sinners, as well as the greatest saints find consolation in the confessional. Simply cast aside all uneasiness and anxiety knowing the God you approach is a God of peace who finds delight in our willingness to come to Him. He takes no delight in all the commotion we made inside our soul, but seeks to give to us only good. Do what you can and confess with a sincere heart as far as you are able, and remain at peace and do not be disturbed by the suggestions of the enemy or of your own imagination. . - Paul A. Rav



While Planned Parenthood's funding may be changing, nobody knows if this will be permanent or what challenges may come up as a result. Regardless, we continue with our prayer vigils at the clinic and at church and, despite busy summer schedules, hope you can join us for the following Pro-life events:

The monthly prayer event takes place on the public sidewalk in front of the Northland Family Planning Clinic, 3810 17 Mile (just west of Ryan Road) on Saturday, August 2, from 11:30AM to 12:30PM. If you're a teen—or know a teen—who wants to help others grow deeper in their Catholic faith, EDGE might be the perfect fit


N.O.W. is a high school youth ministry where Catholic adults volunteer to walk with high school students as they grow in their faith through community, conversation, and encounter with Christ.


