


Reporting Sexual Abuse

Heart's Deepest Longing

In order to illustrate what takes place at each confession I would now like to share a story from one of our saints: St. Mary Magdalen de' Pazzi. From Italy, she was an Italian Carmelite Nun born in 1566 and died in 1607. Once, when she was in the church of her Convent, where confessions were being heard, she was pouring out her heart to the Lord in the tabernacle before her turn came, and she was caught-up in communication with God when what appeared to her the whole mystical world (spiritual realm) was unveiled before her. She saw the souls of each one of the penitents while they were confessing. Then, at the moment the words of Absolution were given, she saw the divine Blood of Jesus mystically poured upon each of them and washing them. Upon which they become exceedingly pure and holy. Now, if such be the case with one confession, what must be the effect of frequent confession! If the soul becomes so pure, so beautiful, when washed only once, when washed in the Blood of the Heart of Jesus - which is applied to us in the Sacrament of Reconciliation; how beautiful must she become when she is cleansed frequently! Brown and soiled linen is not only made clean by frequent washing, but is made white as snow. Should a soul, then, often washed in the divine Blood of Jesus, become, at last, perfectly pure and unutterably beautiful? We can use this image when making our own confessions today. It will increase our love for the Holy Sacrament. Christs' Heart is a true refuge for sinners, which all of us are. When we come to Him with a contrite and humble heart, He will neither cast us off nor despise us. Confession is real and simple; we are the ones who make it difficult for ourselves. - Paul A. Ray


